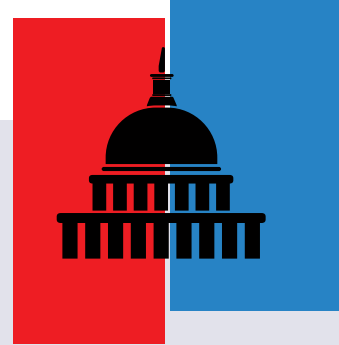


# Key posts on House, Senate panels could be up for grabs
