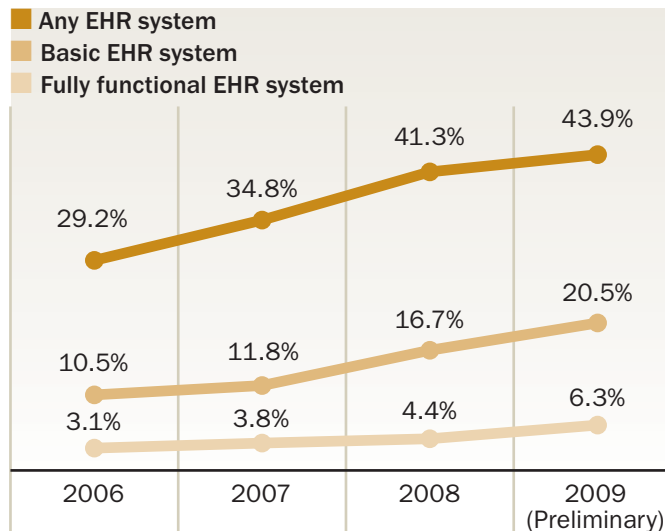

### PLENTY OF GROWTH POTENTIAL

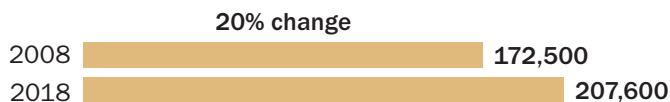
Percentage of office-based physicians using electronic health-record systems

### MORE WORKERS ARE NEEDED

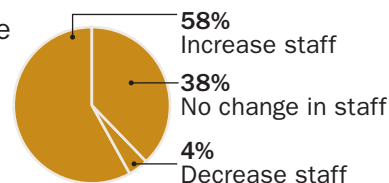
Federal government projections for the growth of medical records and health information technicians



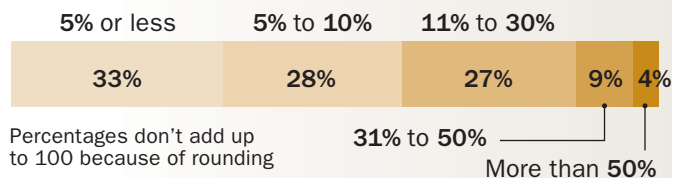

Does your healthcare organization plan to change IT staffing levels in the next 12 months?



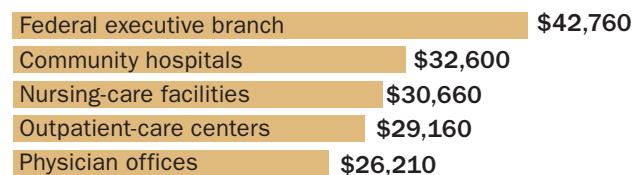
For those planning to increase staff, by what percentage do you see an IT staffing-level increase?

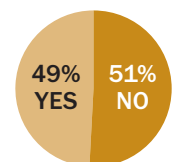
### HOW MUCH ARE THEY PAID?
