WMC names new chief executive officer

FRANKLIN, Tenn. – Williamson Medical Center’s Board of Trustees has unanimously voted to confirm Don Webb, F.H.F.M.A., as chief executive officer, effective July 27.

Webb began his tenure at WMC in 1985 and has served as the Medical Center’s chief financial officer for the past 16 years. He has nearly 40 years of progressively responsible health care financial management experience from a variety of health care facilities.

Webb has served as acting CEO since the June 30 retirement of Dennis Miller, F.A.C.H.E., F.H.F.M.A., who left WMC after 10 years at its helm. A certified public accountant, Webb is a fellow in the Healthcare Financial Management Association and serves as a member of the Tennessee State Board of Accountancy and the Tennessee Chapter of the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants.
