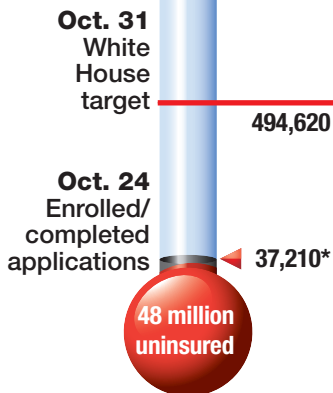


Enrollment Obameter
